As the successful candidate, you will ensure a safe and enjoyable leisure experience for patrons while performing lifeguarding and instructional activities. Your training and keen eye for detail will allow you to actively respond to emergency situations by performing rescue functions and providing assistance to patrons in need. Your strong communication and relationship building skills will be essential as you provide instruction in a variety of aquatic and related programs. In addition, you will conduct regular inspections of rescue and emergency equipment, monitor pool chemistry as required and perform assigned janitorial and maintenance tasks as required.

To be considered for this position you must have the following certifications:

- Red Cross Water Safety Instructor
- National Lifeguard (Pool Option)
- CPR Level C with AED - (within 1 year as per NL requirement)

***All certifications must be current and copies must be submitted with your online application in order to be considered for the position. Recertifications that are completed during the recruitment and selection process must be uploaded to the online portal for your application to remain in competition. During employment, it is the responsibility of the employee to ensure certifications are valid at all times.**

This position is unionized, CUPE Local 774, and the hourly rate of pay is from \$20.41 to \$24.01.

Timeline: Skills Screenings will be held near the end of each month (numbers permitting), with interviews the following week.
