Position Title: WaterWise Safety Team Member (2 open positions)
Terms: Seasonal Contract, Full-time
Start date: May 15, 2024

Work schedule: 40 hours per week
Shifts may vary; flexibility is required for evening/weekend events.
Travel: Travel throughout British Columbia is required for program delivery.

Key responsibilities:

- Travel throughout the province to deliver public education through media and demonstrations at community events, schools, camps, beaches, lakes, and marinas
- Interact with the public in a professional and friendly manner
- Be well-versed in water/boating safety and Lifesaving Society programs
- Provide a high level of knowledge and enthusiasm for water safety
- Keeping regular logs and providing reports as required
- Performing regular checks of event equipment and team vehicle to ensure proper working order, reporting deficiencies to the Executive Director, and protecting the assets of the Lifesaving Society through appropriate use of vehicle and equipment

The two-member WaterWise Education Team travels throughout the province encouraging safety around the water through media, public education and demonstrations at community events, camps, beaches, lakes, and marinas. Must be willing to travel and work flexible hours, including weekends. Must enjoy public presentation, be enthusiastic and have water safety/boating experience such as Lifeguarding, Swim Instruction, or other water related training/skills. All travel expenses are covered, and a team vehicle is provided. Must be fully licensed with a valid B.C. driver's license and provide a clear driver's abstract. Successful candidates will be required to provide a current and satisfactory Criminal Reference Check with Vulnerable Sector Search. The Lifesaving Society values its human resources (staff and volunteer) as the key to fulfilling our mandate of drowning and injury prevention. We provide a friendly, yet busy office environment in which staff must provide excellent service to our clientele, the program providers.
