- Provide a high level of knowledge and enthusiasm for water safety
- Keeping regular logs and providing reports as required
- Performing regular checks of event equipment and team vehicle to ensure proper working order, reporting deficiencies to the Executive Director, and protecting the assets of the Lifesaving Society through appropriate use of vehicle and equipment.

The two-member WaterWise Safety Team travels throughout Victoria and the Capital Regional District encouraging safety around the water through the media, public education and demonstrations at community events, beaches, lakes and marinas. Must have access to a vehicle and be willing to work flexible hours, including weekends. Must enjoy public speaking, be enthusiastic and have water safety/boating experience such as Lifeguarding, Swim Instruction, or other water related training/skills. Must be fully licensed with a valid B.C. driver's license and provide a driver's abstract.
