Terms of Employment

- Starting: Late June through September long weekend. 30-40 hours per week.
- Hourly Wage: Dependent on certifications and experience

- Crew Members are expected to reside on-site during their work week, unless they live nearby. We offer limited staff accommodation on our site for \$100/month, which includes private sleeping cabin rooms (shared with one other person). - Provide info and safety briefing to all guests and enforce water safety policies
- Act as the first responder and administer first aid as needed
- Supervise the waterpark ensuring people are following rules and regulations
- Clean/sanitize and maintain the waterpark, equipment and waterpark kiosk
- Interact with clients to inform them about the lake and our services
- Clean the waterpark docks of garbage or belongings. Bring items to the lost and found as required
- Close the waterpark kiosk, stack chairs, haul garbage
- Other duties as required
- Make sure all our clients get the best out of their summer
