

UBC SPRING BREAK AQUATIC DAYCAMP LEADER

Job Description:

UBC Aquatic Centre Day Camps are looking for Spring Break Aquatic Daycamp Leaders who have experience working with children (ages 7 to 14 years) in a camp setting with specialty interests in either Aquatics or General Sports.

Camps run between 9am and 4pm for a 6 hour day. This position requires leaders to be wet and in the water directly supervising and engaging campers. Instructors will be responsible for: program implementation, supervising groups of youth (ages 7-14 years), teaching swimming skills, delivering recreational activities for children in the water, outside and in the classroom, and assisting with the organization of games and activities.

Pay: \$21.00 per hour plus 4% in lieu of benefits.
