Core job duties include:

- Ensures the safety of pool users in accordance with established safety guidelines
- Performs lifesaving duties including first aid, resuscitation and other emergency revival techniques as required
- Instructs pool users of various ages in proper water safety
- Swimming and lifesaving techniques, test and certifies, as qualified, to various levels of established national swimming/lifesaving standards
- Leads aqua-fit, lifesaving and other aquatic programs
- Responsible for the day-to-day maintenance and janitorial duties relating to the pool and surrounding areas such as deck, changing rooms, water chemical and filtration systems, etc.

Qualifications and Certifications:

- National Lifeguard Certification- *Required*
- Lifesaving Swim instructor – *Required*
- Standard first Aid with CPR C/AED (intermediate) - *Required*
- AMOA -Airway Management & Oxygen Administration – *Preferred*
- Recognized fitness knowledge certification and/or Aquafit Instructor- *Preferred*
- Pool Operator Level I- *Preferred*
- Life Saving Instructor- *Preferred*

Salary: This position is a unionized position under CUPE local 2698. The hourly wage rate is **\$30.99/hour** (plus an additional **\$2.00/hour** in lieu of benefits and premiums + vacation pay) pursuant to the current Collective Agreement and *Employment Standards Act*.
