Position Title:	WaterWise Safety Team Member (2 open positions)
Terms:	Seasonal Contract, Full-time
Contract Dates:	May 18 – August 24, 2026
Rate of Pay:	\$22.50/hour based on a 37.5 hour work week
Work Schedule:	37.5 hours per week; shifts may vary; flexibility is required for travel and evening/weekend events

Nature & Scope:

The two-member WaterWise Safety Team travels throughout British Columbia promoting water safety through informational tables, media, and demonstrations at beaches, waterfronts, schools, and community events. WaterWise team members must enjoy interacting with the public in person and through social media and have water safety/boating experience, such as lifeguarding, swim instruction, or other water related training/skills.

Key responsibilities:

- Travel throughout British Columbia to deliver public education through media and demonstrations at schools, events, beaches, lakes, and marinas.
- Interact with the public in a professional and friendly manner.
- Create, share, and represent the Lifesaving Society in water safety focused social media videos and photos. Must be comfortable on camera.
- Provide a high level of knowledge and enthusiasm for water/boating safety and Lifesaving Society programs.
- Keep regular logs and provide reports as required.
- Perform regular checks of event equipment and team vehicle to ensure proper working order, reporting deficiencies to supervisors, and protecting the assets of the Lifesaving Society through appropriate use of vehicle and equipment.

Requirements:

- Water safety/boating experience such as lifeguarding, swim instruction, or other water-related training/skills
- Effective verbal and written communicator with excellent interpersonal skills
- Competency in Microsoft Office, Teams, and social media (Instagram, Facebook)
- Valid Class 5 B.C. driver's license with clear driver's abstract
- Hold a current Standard First Aid & CPR-C certification
- Ability to travel and work flexible hours
