Seasonal Community Pool Lifeguards are hired to help ensure successful community programming at the Armstrong Spallumcheen Outdoor Pool for the 2026 season. This position is central to delivering programs to the community and region while also providing communication to all customers, guests and visitors regarding inquiries and information related to the Armstrong Spallumcheen Outdoor Pool.

SCOPE:

Reporting to the Seasonal Aquatic Coordinator, the Seasonal Community Pool Lifeguard provides safety supervision, public relations, and facility cleaning and upkeep for the Armstrong Spallumcheen Outdoor Pool. As a member of the aquatics team, the position provides cooperative assistance and strong customer service excellence.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintain a high level of physical fitness to ensure Lifesaving Society fitness standards are met at all times.
- Stay up to date on all facility procedures.
- Provide consistent and vigilant safety supervision in accordance with National Lifeguard Standards.
- Deliver Lifesaving techniques, first aid, airway management and oxygen administration according to certification.
- Communicate efficiently to all other employees.
- Communicate efficiently to the public using strong public relations skills.
- Maintain all required and relevant paperwork and records.
- Attend all in-services and any extra training required.
- Demonstrate safe work practices at all times, including proper use of cleaning supplies and adherence to established safety procedures.
- Conducts facility safety checks, ensures that the facility is up to cleanliness standards at all time and assists with facility upkeep.
- Assists in running activities for special events

QUALIFICATIONS:

Required:

- National Lifeguard (NL) – current within 2 years
- Airway Management and Oxygen Administration (AMOA) – current
- Standard First Aid – Current within 3 years
- CPR-C & AED – Current within 3 years

EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION:

- Excellent oral and written communication skills in English; neat in appearance; professional attitude; and understanding of the sensitivity of confidential information.
- Must be thorough, organized, articulate and punctual.
- Must work well under pressure with strong attention to details.
- Ability to work flexible schedule including evenings and weekends.
- Completion of a Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Check.
